



NORTH AMERICAN HAIR RESEARCH SOCIETY MENTORSHIPS

SCIENTISTS-IN-TRAINING, DERMATOLOGY
& DERMATOPATHOLOGY RESIDENTS,
FELLOWS, AND JUNIOR FACULTY

DESCRIPTION: Grants up to \$3000 each can be awarded to scientists in training, dermatology or dermatopathology residents, fellows, or junior faculty to enable study with a hair research mentor. Either the mentor or the applicant must be a member of the North American Hair Research Society.

PURPOSE: To enable young physicians and scientists to acquire additional academic or research skills that will further their careers as leaders in hair research. *Note that the focus of the program is on establishing a mentoring relationship, not a specific research project.*

TIME PERIOD: March, 2010 – February, 2011

APPLICATION PROCESS: All applications must include:

1. A completed application form.
2. A budget outlining expenses to be incurred (up to a maximum of \$3000).
3. A letter from the proposed mentor to include a statement of willingness to provide the time necessary for this mentorship, any significant and pertinent details of the planned mentorship, and a specific mention of whether the time frame and budget are appropriate for the proposed mentorship.
4. A letter from the department chair attesting to the applicant's character and potential to benefit from the mentorship.
5. A curriculum vitae.

POST-MENTORSHIP: A one page written report by the applicant summarizing the experience and what was learned is required after the mentorship has been completed.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Completed applications must be received by November 30, 2009 for awards to be announced by February, 2010.
